DISCUSSION

John Martin, as an outside consultant working for FirstEnergy Nuclear Operating Company following the discovery of degradation of Davis-Besse's reactor pressure vessel head, interviewed Mr. Geisen and other Davis-Besse personnel about their activities related to NRC Bulletin 2001-01. Therefore, his testimony is relevant to the issues raised by the enforcement action.
