SUBJECT: HONEYWELL METROPOLIS WORK REQUEST TO CLARIFY THE
DESIGNATION OF CERTAIN RADIOACTIVE WASTE PRESENT ON THEIR
SITE

Dear Mr. Klebe:

As you are aware, by letter dated March 30, 2006, the Honeywell Metropolis Works (Honeywell) facility in Metropolis, Illinois, requested that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) consider whether various wastes present at the facility constitute "by-product material" as defined in the Atomic Energy Act and 10 CFR Part 40 (Enclosure 1). In previous letters dated February 16, 2001, and January 16, 2003 (Enclosures 2 & 3), the State of Illinois Department of Nuclear Safety addressed similar issues raised by Honeywell in the past.

Before taking action on Honeywell's request, the NRC staff would like to discuss these issues with you.

We are proposing a video conference at a date to be determined within 45 days of this letter.
