Dear Ms. Leverton:

This is in reference to your letter dated December 14, 2006 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 29-15765-02. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. If licensed materials are to be used in animals, please submit:
 - a. a description of the animal housing facilities,
 - b. confirmation that you will abide by the training description provided in your letter dated January 31, 1995; or confirmation that you will use Appendix H of NUREG-1556, Volume 7 (enclosed) to address considerations for laboratory animal uses.
2. Please submit the name of a different individual who will serve as the management representative. The management representative usually is not an authorized user. Based on interviews during the most recent inspection, Brian Webb is an authorized user and works for Kathryn Leverton, the radiation safety officer (RSO). A management representative is usually a chief executive officer or other management individual or delegate to whom the RSO reports and who has the authority to manage, direct, or administer the licensee's activities.
