Gentlemen:

Please consider this a request for a hearing regarding your published notice with respect to same on behalf of Cumberland County.

Cumberland County is immediately adjacent to the Shieldalloy site and sits downgrade and down wind to the facility.

Cumberland County has taken a position consistent with that of Gloucester County and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection that proposals to decommission the site and allow it to sit there unremediated for hundreds, if not thousands of years is the inappropriate manner in which the site should be handled because of concerns to the health, safety and welfare of the general public in the area surrounding the site and in the area impacted by the site.

It is the position of Cumberland County that the slag materials that are the subject of the regulatory control of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission should be removed from the site in an environmentally sound manner and taken to an approved landfill for disposal thus eliminating and alleviating the prospective and potential health impacts on the public.




