Under the Freedom of Information Act, Public Law 89-487, 90-23, and 93-502, I am requesting a copy of the NRC active contracts listing to include (as available) Contract #, Contractor name, Contracting Officer, program office organization code, obligated dollars, contract ceiling, Brief Work Description or title of work, award date, place of performance, SIC code, and Solicitation Procedure(e.g., full and open, or small business set aside). Please sort this information by contract number if the source medium allows. I am only requesting information on contracts with FY 2006 expenditures greater than \$100K dollars. Please provide a legend for codes associated with any reported data fields. This information is believed to be located in the NRC policy area with Mr. Steven Pool. In order to minimize the administrative response burden on the government, I am willing to accept any current standard report from NRC that includes these data fields, or close to them. This information is not publicly available through GSA FPDS for FY 2006.

I am also requesting a current copy of the names of all assigned COTR's at NRC and their assigned contracts by contract numbers. This information is believed to be available through Ms. Louise Wiggins. Both Mr. Pool and Ms. Wiggins are reachable through the NRC information operator on 301-415-7000.
