Item 1:

Item 3:

This is to confirm that a typographical error has occurred on page 20. We confirm that we will use Table N.1 instead of table P.1.

Item 4:

Typographical error on page 43: This is to confirm that we commit to following 10 CFR 35.80 (a) (4).

Item 5:

Typographical error on page 46: This is to confirm that we will follow and check dose measurement instruments as described in 10 CFR 35.60 or 10 CFR 35.63.

Items 6 and 7:

We commit to the emergency procedures as specified in Appendix V of NUREG 1556 Volume 9.

The mobile van is fitted with a security alarm. When transporting radioactive material, the van is always be in constant surveillance by the driver/technologist. While transporting radioactive material, all doors and windows are in locked position including driver's compartment. A cell phone access is provided for the driver in case of any emergency and to immediately notify the radiation safety officer. The contact numbers of emergency personnel will be located inside the van. We commit to carry extra shielded containers (a minimum of two) if byproduct material that may become detached and/or dislodged during the transportation or in an event.

The transport vehicle, including driver's compartment will be secured at all times from any unauthorized access when the vehicle is unattended.

The Van Make and Model are Dodge Sprinter.

License plate Number is VKB31Z.

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Item 8:

Transportation: We commit to adopt procedures specified in Appendix V of NUREG 1556 Volume 9. We will develop, document, and implement procedures to assure that the following will take place:

Radioactive material is transported in accordance with the 49 CFR 170-189. These procedures will include:

- Use of approved packages;
- Use of approved labeling;
- Conduct of proper surveys;
- Complete and accurate shipping papers;
- Bracing of packages;
- Security provisions; and
- Written emergency instructions.

We commit to perform audits, at least annually, of transportation documentation, including shipping papers and survey reports and activities at client facilities. The radioactive material is secured at all times during transportation and use at the client's facilities.

Item 9:

We do not provide scan-in-van service. We will move our mobile gamma camera into the client's facility and perform scans within the client's facility. The client's facility will have the temporary hot lab, waiting, examining, imaging, reading, office, file storage area, fresh material storage area, toilets, closet, etc. Since we perform all activities in client's facility and only transport gamma camera and radioactive materials to the client's facility, the patients use sink and toilet facilities located at the client's facility. We will dispose all radioactive waste accordance with 10 CFR 20 Subpart K-Waste Disposal.
