


I am writing on behalf of the membership of the Employee Concerns Program Forum to thank you for the support the Nuclear Regulatory Commission has provided to our national association over the years and to ask for your continued support.

The ECP Forum is a non-profit organization dedicated to promoting healthy and professional alternate issue-reporting/resolution programs. Membership is open to individual professionals engaged or interested in the fields of employee concerns, alternative dispute resolution, Safety Conscious Work Environment, and Safety Culture. The majority of our membership is made up of ECP representatives from the nuclear power industry; however, it also includes those representing materials licensees, whistleblower rights, and other government agencies, such as the Departments of Labor and Energy. This diverse membership allows for valuable dialogue on issues from a variety of stakeholder viewpoints.

The primary vehicle for serving our members is our national meeting, where we provide training, discussion of emerging topics, peer exchange, and most importantly, direct interface with the NRC. Attendee feedback consistently rates our breakout sessions with NRC Regional Allegation Coordinators as the most valuable experience provided by the Forum. Licensee ECP managers and staffers report that the face-to-face meeting with their Regional Coordinators improves understanding and encourages dialogue well beyond the Forum session. The Allegation Program Annual Trends Report provided by the Agency Allegation Advisor – and the discussion that follows – forms much of the focus for future attention by ECP programs and by Safety Culture and Safety Conscious Work Environment (SCWE) programs as well.

Were these few, key NRC representatives unable to participate in our Forum meetings, it is likely our member programs would suffer. Please give this valuable collaborative process the funding and support needed to ensure its continuation.
