Highway Route Approval Application (NRC No. 192)
Route: Naval Weapons Station to Savannah River Site

By application dated January 3, 2007, the TLI Secured Transportation Services, LLC requested an approval of a route to transport spent fuel from the Naval Weapons Station to Savannah River Site. This request identifies additional information needed by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff in connection with its review of the application. This request describes information needed by the staff for it to complete its review of the application and to determine whether the applicant has demonstrated compliance with regulatory requirements.

1. Verify and re-submit the routes provided for roads in Enclosures 1 and 2 of your proposed route application from Naval Weapons Station to Savannah River Site.

The route information in Enclosures 1 and 2 are inconsistent. For example, Enclosure 1 is missing two roads that are listed in Enclosure 2. Routes used for road shipments of spent fuel must be approved in advance in accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 73.37.

2. Revise Enclosure 2 to include locations of the safe havens along the route.

The safe haven information provided in Enclosure 2 is incomplete. The staff notes that the response to this request for additional information is Safeguards Information and should be handled in accordance with 10 CFR 73.37.
