This is an amendment to notify NRC that we are requesting modification of our license to:


1. Remove Timothy R. Whiteman, M.D., our facilities current RSO and authorized user from the license.

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RADIATION SAFETY OFFICER'S DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

Delegation of Authority:

You, **John J. Mathis, D.O.**, have been appointed **Radiation Safety Officer** and are responsible for ensuring the safe use of radiative materials as used under the **NRC** License. As provided for in the license, you are responsible for managing the radiation protection program; identifying radiation protection problems; initiating, recommending, or providing corrective action; verifying implementation of corrective actions; stopping unsafe activities; and ensuring compliance with regulations pertaining to the Nuclear Medicine Program. You are hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet those responsibilities, including prohibiting the use of radiopharmaceuticals and radioactive materials by employees who do not meet the necessary requirements and shutting down operations where justified by radiation safety. You are required to notify management of situations where staff are not cooperating and addressing radiation safety issues. In addition, you are free to raise issues with the **NRC** at any time.
