Dear Robert,

The reason we included NY as a "high priority action" with regards of FSME-06-110 is because we have NRD (lic. # NY-DOL 1391-181) listed as a manufacturer and distributor. NRD received the M&D Order and is implementing it, therefore it must be authorized to manufacture or distribute Cat 2 and above sources. If NRD is not authorized to manufacture Cat 2 sources, but is authorized to distribute, then you don't need to take any action. Please give me a call at your earliest convenience if we need to clarify this further.

Ernesto and Scott:

NY is listed on FSME-06-110 as a state with "High Priority Action", presumably with respect to the February 6, 2007 implementation date for serialization of Category 2 and above sources.

Please note the New York State Department of Health (including commercial/industrial) does not have any licensees who are authorized to manufacture Category 2 or above sources. Therefore we do not need to take any action related to 10 CFR 32.201 ("Serialization of nationally tracked sources").

Would you please indicate what information you have that indicates that NYS has licensees authorized to manufacture Category 2 and above sources.
