We need radiation standards that do the following:

1. Protect the most vulnerable by exercising precaution since no level of radiation dose is safe.
2. Recognize that "allowable" levels are not safe. Current permitted levels of radiation are based on the model of a young, healthy, white male and ignore vulnerable infants and children, the elderly, those in poor health, and women (who are considerably more vulnerable to radiation than men).
3. Consider radiation damage from inhaling or ingesting radiation. NRC does not currently consider the effects of internal radiation.
