It was a pleasure meeting you yesterday.


This follows up on the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's ("NRC's") request to formally request that written materials Kakivik Asset Management ("Kakivik") provided to the NRC at yesterday's predecisional conference be treated as confidential in accordance with the NRC's administrative rules.

As we discussed, the written materials hand-delivered to the NRC yesterday contain information regarding Kakivik's security measures, and as such should be treated as "security-related sensitive information" and not be made publicly available in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390. In addition, the written materials contain personal information that could adversely affect the interests of Kakivik's employees if publicly disclosed and should also be treated as confidential as provided in 10 CFR 2.390.
