**Suggested Talking Points for my Comments**

NRC did a bad job assessing environmental impact for this proposal:

- There was no independent research/modeling of impact of catastrophic event (i.e. "no new data were measured or derived as part of this report.")
- It is inappropriate to use an inspection report from a Pennsylvania facility. Hawaii is different and should be viewed as such.
- They should have considered an airplane crash's impact on the facility and the effect of losing control of radioactive material.
- They should have addressed security issues.
- People in Hawai'i do not WANT irradiated food no matter how safe they claim it is.
