RESOLUTION # 67-95

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING SHIELDALLOY METALLURGICAL CORPORATION'S APPLICATION TO THE NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, Shieldalloy Metallurgical has developed a new additive that will reduce impurities in the steel manufacturing process; and

WHEREAS, This new product named CANAL-Slag Fluidizer, has a low melting point, thereby reducing the amount of energy required to introduce it into the steel making process and reducing impurities in the end product; and

WHEREAS, Shieldalloy Metallurgical Corporation manufactures this product by using slag materials left over from other manufacturing processes; and

WHEREAS, The slag material was considered a by-product until Shieldalloy Metallurgical Corporation developed the CANAL-Slag Fluidizer, process, allowing the company to recycle some of the slag from their plant; and

WHEREAS, the CANAL- Slag Fluidizer is regulated by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission; and

WHEREAS, Shieldalloy Metallurgical Corporation has made application to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to export CANAL-Slag Fluidizer; and

WHEREAS, This process, if approved, will allow Shieldalloy Metallurgical Corporation to receive economic benefits and also provide environmental relief to the Borough of Newfield; and

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council of the Borough of Newfield are supportive of Shieldalloy Metallurgical Corporation's plans to export CANAL-Slag Fluidizer; and

WHEREAS, Any affirmative taken to reduce or limit slag materials on site at Shieldalloy Metallurgical Corporation would be in the best interest of the Borough and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, The actions of Shieldalloy Metallurgical Corporation in its attempt to reduce and limit slag materials is an effort to be commended because of the potential positive effects such action will have on the Borough of Newfield and its citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Mayor and Council of the Borough of Newfield that a request is made of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission that it grant and or permit Shieldalloy Metallurgical Corporation permission or a license to export CANAL-Slag Fluidizer; and, that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission support and assist the Shieldalloy Metallurgical Corporation in its efforts to obtain such a license to export Canal Slag Fluidizer.
