
We would like to amend our license to address the following changes:

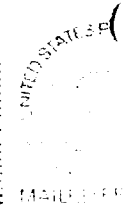
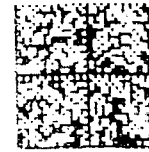
