Subject: Inspection 40-7102/77-01

This refers to your letter dated January 10, 1978, in response to our letter dated January 3, 1978.

Thank you for informing us of the corrective and preventive actions documented in your letter. These actions will be examined during a subsequent inspection of your licensed program.

You are correct in your statement that a survey is an evaluation, by physical measurement and/or calculation, of the radiation hazards incident to the use of radioactive materials under a specific set of conditions. However, you are advised that it is necessary to verify any assumptions that you have made, initially and on occasions when conditions indicate that a change may have occurred. Specifically, you should verify that the volume of effluent air released and the efficiency of your baghouse filters are, in fact, within the designed specifications and that these parameters do not vary significantly with changing conditions such as normal loading of the baghouse filters. These matters will be reviewed during the next inspection of your licensed program.
