STATEMENT OF INTENT

As Chancellor of the University of Missouri - Rolla, I exercise express authority and responsibility to approve funding for decommissioning activities associated with operations authorized by U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Material License No. 24-00513-40. This authority is established by Section 70.010C of the University of Missouri, Board of Curators, *Collected Rules and Regulations*. Within this authority, I intend to have funds made available when necessary in an amount up to \$750,000 to decommission all facilities belonging to UMR where radioactive materials are used. I intend to request and obtain these funds sufficiently in advance of decommissioning to prevent delay of required activities.

A copy of Section 70.010C is attached as evidence that I am authorized to represent the University of Missouri - Rolla in this transaction.
