Dear FOI Officer:

Pursuant to the federal Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552, I request access to and copies of correspondence, memoranda, reports and other information concerning International Atomic Energy Agency visits since Jan. 1, 2000, to the BWXT facility at Lynchburg, Va. Additionally, any correspondence, memos or reports referring to the application of the Additional Protocol to the BWXT site.

I agree to pay reasonable duplication fees for the processing of this request in an amount not to exceed \$50. However, please notify me prior to incurring any expenses in excess of that amount.

As a representative of the news media, I am only required to pay for the direct cost of duplication after the first 100 pages. This information is being sought on behalf of Media General News Service for dissemination to the general public via company-owned newspapers and television stations.

If my request is denied in whole or part, I ask that you justify all deletions by reference to specific exemptions of the act. I will also expect you to release all segregable portions of otherwise exempt material. I, of course, reserve the right to appeal your decision to withhold any information or to deny a waiver of fees.

As I am making this request as a journalist and this information is of timely value, I would appreciate your communicating with me by telephone, rather than by mail, if you have questions regarding this request.

I look forward to your reply within 20 business days, as the statute requires.
