**Background:** This procedure describes the procedure for conducting reviews of the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission Regional and Agreement State radioactive materials programs using the common performance indicator, Technical Quality of Licensing Actions. The procedure is being revised to reflect the recent NRC reorganization and to clearly define the rationale for performing judgemental samples when selecting licensing casework for evaluation.
