PROGRAM SCOPE

The licensee is authorized to manufacture, process and/or package radiopharmaceuticals and/or radiochemicals. This inspection focused solely on the corrective actions associated with and escalated enforcement action identified during a special inspection conducted on October 16-17, 2006 documented in inspection report number 030-00001/2006-002. The violation involved (1) the release of radioactive material to the sanitary sewer system in excess of the NRC's regulatory limits; and (2) the failure to fully implement your sanitary sewer release procedure.

Observations and Findings

The inspector noted that the licensee had changed the sanitary sewer release procedure as discussed in the response to the NRC's Notice of Violation. The inspector verified that personnel required to implement the procedure were aware of the new procedure and had adequate resources and knowledge to implement the procedure. The inspector also reviewed sewer disposal records and did not identify any additional releases in excess of NRC regulatory limits. The inspector was given a tour of the areas where RAM is released to the sewer and the licensee verbally demonstrated compliance with the new procedure.
