Dear Ms. Kreisler:

Enclosed for your consideration is a request dated December 22, 2006, from Diversified Scientific Services, Inc. (DSSI), a wholly-owned subsidiary of Perma-Fix Environmental Services, Inc., for Amendment No. 04 to License IW004, involving the import of Class A radioactive mixed waste from Canada for processing at DSSI's Industrial Boiler Facility. The purpose of the amendment is to extend the license expiration date from December 31, 2006 to December 31, 2008. No other changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license were requested and DSSI would be required to maintain domestic authorizations to receive and process the imported material and comply with applicable international and/or domestic requirements.

To date, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has received no responses to our letter to the Executive Branch dated December 28, 2006, or the Federal Register notice concerning this amendment, which was published on January 18, 2007 (72 FR 2313). Before issuing this minor amendment, we are contacting you and sending similar letters to the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation, and the Southeast Low-Level Radioactive Waste Compact, and requesting comments on the proposed license extension.
