## STATEMENT OF INTENT

As Commandant of the United States Army Chemical School, I exercise express authority and responsibility to approve funding for decommissioning activities associated with operations authorized by the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission under licenses issued to the Chemical School. This authority is established by Army Regulation 37-1, Army Accounting and Fund Control. Within this authority, I intend to have funds made available when necessary in an amount up to \$750,000 to decommission the Radiological Laboratories, U.S. Army Chemical School. I intend to request and obtain these funds sufficiently in advance of decommissioning to prevent delay of required activities.

A copy of my assumption of command is attached as evidence that I am authorized to represent the U.S. Army Chemical School in this transaction.
