Enclosed is Amendment No. 08 to your NRC Material License No. 21-26632-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold font**.

Please note that license conditions 14 through 19 were removed from your license as a result of the April 2005 rule changes to 10 CFR Part 35. Each of the aforementioned license conditions are incorporated into the regulations. In addition, note that three new license conditions have been added in accordance with NRC's current license formatting policies and procedures.

Please note that by License Condition 16 you are required to comply with the "Increased Controls for Licensees that Possess Sources Containing Radioactive Material Quantities of Concern" (IC) (ADAMS Accession No. ML053130364) published as "Attachment B" to the "Orders Imposing Increased Controls" (ML053130218) in the Federal Register on December 1, 2005 (70 FR 72128). This License Condition requires that you complete implementation of said requirements by the first day that radionuclides in quantities of concern are possessed at or above the limits specified in "Table 1: Radionuclides of Concern" found in the IC, and notify, in writing, the Director, Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Management Programs, USNRC, Washington, DC, 20555, when you have completed the requirements of this License Condition. Your response must be marked as "Security-Related Information - Withhold Under 10 CFR 2.390".

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

NRC's Regulatory Issue Summary (RIS) 2005-31 provides criteria to identify security-related sensitive information and guidance for handling and marking of such documents. This ensures that potentially sensitive information is not made publicly available through ADAMS, the NRC's electronic document system. Pursuant to NRC's RIS 2005-31 and in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, the enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.
