

PROGRAM SCOPE

The licensee was a medical clinic located in Dearborn, Michigan. The licensee was authorized to conduct licensed activities under 10 CFR Sections 35.100 and 35.200. The licensee contracted one full-time nuclear medicine technologists (NMT). The licensee performed approximately 5-10 diagnostic cardiac studies usually on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, using technetium-99m. The radioactive material was received in unit doses at the main office from a local pharmacy. All waste was either held for decay-in-storage or returned to the pharmacy.

PERFORMANCE OBSERVATIONS

During the inspection, the inspector reviewed select records and observed: (1) adequate security of the licensed material; (2) adequate posting of areas; (3) package receipt and return surveys; (4) responses to emergency scenarios; (5) survey meter use and calibration; (6) daily contamination surveys; (7) weekly wipes; (8) dose calibrator constancy checks; and (9) sealed source inventory.

No violations of NRC requirements were identified.
