
Through an internal miscommunication, we are late in notifying you that we have fully moved into our new facility and have discontinued use of the old facility. We fully moved into our new facility at the end of April and performed a close-out survey at the old facility on May 3, 2006. The report was sent to our nuclear medicine technologist along with a draft amendment letter with instructions to retype both on letterhead, get administrator signatures and then forward them to your office. She apparently did not do so which was discovered during our annual review of our radiation safety program/license. She has since left the practice.

The close-out survey showed that no residual radioactive contamination was present at the time of the survey. This is consistent with Tc-99m being the only unsealed radioactive material used in our practice and a week had passed between the removal of all radioactive material from the lab and the close-out survey.

Please delete all references to the 757 Norland Ave, Suite 207 site. All radioactive materials are used at 755 Norland Ave, Suite 201, Chambersburg, PA 17201.

Gentlemen.

We have decommissioned our old facility and moved into our new one as per our last amendment. Only 35,200 materials were ever used or stored in the room. The following is a close-out survey performed on May 3, 2006.

A gross contamination smear was taken on all walls and floor, door and doorknob. The smear covered 80% of the surface area of the walls and floor. The smear was counted in a Capintec Caprac well counter with efficiency for Tc-99m which is greater than 90% and minimum detectable activity of 85. Area radiation level surveys were taken at each smear site. The background for the area survey was 0.02 mR/hr using a Ludlum 14C survey meter last calibrated on November 1, 2005. All readings were 0.02 mR/hr.

Background for the wipe test was 458. CPM of the gross smear was 366. Wipe survey indicated no activity present or 0 dpm. This is consistent with the exclusive storage of Tc-99m in this area with the last use of the room occurring more than a week prior to the close-out survey.

We have released the room for unrestricted use.

The survey was performed by technologist Ellen Drake and Radiation Safety Officer Mark Perna.
