Dear Mr. Comfort,

Just a belated letter to thank you for your prompt reply of January 13 regarding Shieldalloy and the decommissioning plan.

The background and EIS outline in the Federal Register and the page from NUREG-1444 were very informative. I have requested the entire publication from the U.S. Printing Office.

A snowy day today has afforded me the first time to do a first reading of the transcript of the December 16 scoping meeting. I must say the effort to get any "clear" picture of the situation on the part of the citizens remains elusive, with bits of information on various areas sort of randomly materializing through the question/answer process. I realize that that was not the purpose of the scoping meeting, but it is difficult to express concerns without information.

Was there a safety evaluation report done on Shiledally in '93 ?
When is the environmental assessment for Shieldalloy taking place ?
In my notes from our phone conversation , I understood you to say this spring .
Has the plant's license been renewed ? For how long ? With or without this assessment or financial assurance information for decommissioning ?

Meanwhile, here in South Jersey several townships have passed resolutions (I have enclosed two, one from Franklin Township, and one from Washington Township). We collected 240 signatures on a petition to the Newfield Borough government (sample petition enclosed, I have copies of the signed ones on file). We presented the petition at last Borough Council meeting of February 8. Much to our surprise the Borough Council put together a resolution #31-94; so hastily that it did not even appear on the agenda along with other resolutions at that meeting. I will forward a copy of it to you when I get it. Anyway suffice it to say that we continue to find a even larger community concerned with responsible actions in terms of the present and continuing accumulation of contamination at the site.

Please continue to keep us informed of the latest environmental data being gathered and the developments in the EIS process.

Again, thank you for your consideration.


