


<b>LICENSEE:</b>  The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector. The inspection findings are as follows:

<i>10 CFR 35.14(b)(4) requires the licensee to notify the Commission in writing within 30 days of when changes are made to the areas of use identified in the license.</i>			
<i>Contrary to the above, on October 11, 2002, the licensee amended its license and did not provide an accurate description of its area of use. Specifically, the license amendment did not accurately depict the nuclear imaging room and misrepresented the location of the nuclear stress testing room.</i>			
<i>The licensee committed to the submission of a notification letter describing the facility and to accurately describing the facility should future changes be made in the areas of use.</i>			
<b>Licensee's Statement of Corrective Actions for Item 4, above.</b>			
I hereby state that, within 30 days, the actions described by me to the inspector will be taken to correct the violations identified. This statement of corrective actions is made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201 (corrective steps already taken, corrective steps which will be taken, data when full compliance will be achieved).
