PROGRAM SCOPE

The licensee is authorized for possession of licensed material (HDR) through transportation activities only. Once the HDR arrives at its destination, another NRC or Agreement State license receives the RAM, uses and stores the HDR as required. The licensee is authorized to transport two HDR's, the most recent unit had a Ir-192 source installed on 2/15/07. Only two individuals have been authorized to transport the RAM since the last inspection.

Observations and Findings

The inspector interviewed licensee staff and found the individual to have adequate knowledge regarding NRC regulations. The inspector checked all transportation documentation, training documentation, dosimetry records and found they were in compliance with NRC requirements. The inspector also verified that, during transport, licensed material could be properly stored and secured.
