SUBJECT
Control No. 315744 -- Re - Request for license renewal (48-12016-01) by letter dated September 22, 2006.

SUMMARY
In a telephone conversation with Mr. Seaman on this date, the following was discussed:

1. I noted that the license had last been renewed for a period of 1 year as the licensee had indicated an intent to terminate the license shortly after renewal and I inquired, so as to assure that normal renewal for a ten year period was the licensee's current intent. After some discussion, Mr. Seaman requested several days to look into issues involving the NRC's Sealed Source & Device Registry (SS&DR) expense of an NRC licensee vs. a non NRC licensee (since the State of Wisconsin does not have its own SS& DR and the license may have need of these services) and how soon licensing of NORM material is likely to be implemented, and evaluate the economic impact of these matters in making a decision on whether to continue pursuit of license renewal at this time or request termination of their subject NRC license.
2. We also briefly discussed the probable need, in the event that the licensee decides to proceed with the renewal, to submit a renewal application following the guidance in NUREG-1556 Vol.1, Rev. 1, Appendix B..
3. In accord with current NRC policy in support of security issues, if license renewal is to be pursued, the licensee needs to specify a total possession limit, to be added to License Item 8 for each radioisotope (Cesium-137 and Americium-241) listed in License Item 6 of the subject license. The possession limit need only address the possession of licensed material needed for the activities authorized by this license, namely, use for demonstration purposes at temporary job sites.
