**STATEMENT OF WORK FOR DOMESTIC OVERNIGHT  
EXPRESS DELIVERY OF SMALL PACKAGES**

Contractor shall provide next day overnight delivery for approximately 20 packages each day weighing between 1 ounce up to 7- pounds per package within the United States. Packages pickup by the contractor after 6:00p.m. shall be delivered to the destination specified by 10:30 a.m. the following day, including Saturdays. (does not include Federal Holidays)

Contractor shall provide any necessary on-site equipment//software for the Government use in tracking items shipped or received. This system shall track each shipment's status from pickup through point-of-delivery, provide on online method of ordering additional shipping supplies, maintain/store NRC mailing lists and provide detailed daily reports of shipments.

### **A.3 52.217-8 OPTION TO EXTEND SERVICES (NOV 1999)**

The Government may require continued performance of any services within the limits and at the rates specified in the contract. These rates may be adjusted only as a result of revisions to prevailing labor rates provided by the Secretary of Labor. The option provision may be exercised more than once, but the total extension of performance hereunder shall not exceed 6 months. The Contracting Officer may exercise the option by written notice to the Contractor within 15 days.

### **A.4 52.217-9 OPTION TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT (MAR 2000)**

(a) The Government may extend the term of this contract by written notice to the Contractor within 15 days; provided that the Government gives the Contractor a preliminary written notice of its intent to extend at least 30 days before the contract expires. The preliminary notice does not commit the Government to an extension.

(b) If the Government exercises this option, the extended contract shall be considered to include this option clause.

(c) The total duration of this contract, including the exercise of any options under this clause, shall not exceed five years.

## **A.5 SEAT BELTS**
