**Subject: Revised Response to Request For Additional Information For AREVA NP Inc.,
Richland Site-wide Integrated Safety Analysis Summary Review (TAC L31856)**

On April 20, 2006, AREVA NP (AREVA) received a Request For Additional Information (RAI) from the NRC relative to the Integrated Safety Analysis (ISA) Summary for the Richland facility. AREVA has worked with the NRC since that time to resolve concerns and to clarify responses. The attachment to this letter provides the latest revision to the requested additional information. It also contains numerous commitments to revise the ISA Summary by June 30th 2007. Each of these commitments have been entered into the AREVA Corrective Action Program under CR 2006-3362 are being tracked to completion. Also included as an attachment to the RAI response is a discussion of the potential impact of local traffic accidents on the Richland Facility which was requested by Mr. Frederick Burrows via e-mail on 12-21-2006.

Included in the original RAI cover letter was a request for AREVA to inform the NRC of AREVA's plans to provide commitments in the AREVA operating license relative to fourteen key elements. The majority of these commitments were incorporated into the current operating license for AREVA's Richland facility via Amendment 34 (TAC L31583). This amendment placed the commitments contained in the AREVA ISA plan into safety condition S-1 of the current license.

The few commitments that were not included in the NRC approved ISA plan are covered by existing commitments contained in the programs required in the current Richland facility operating license, namely for AREVA to have and maintain Configuration Management and Problem Identification and Corrective Action Follow-up (Investigations and Reporting) programs.

Additionally, AREVA submitted a revised license application on or before October 30, 2006 as part of our timely renewal effort. The license renewal application submitted at that time is in full compliance with the new 10CFR70 requirements, and includes appropriate commitments to the fourteen key elements mentioned in the RAI cover letter.
