To Whom It May Concern:

We wish to amend our NRC license to name Samuel L. Payne, M.S. as our Radiation Safety Officer (RSO). Mr. Payne is our consultant physicist and has agreed to serve as our facilities RSO. Mr. Payne is currently the RSO under NRC license 37-01374-03 at the Mercy Hospital, Scranton, Pennsylvania.

Mr. Payne will be delegated authority in all matters related to radiation safety. The consultant-RSO will be able to exercise authority over the authorized users with relation to radiation safety problems. If an issue should arise in which patient care is involved, the consultant-RSO will discuss these issues with the authorized users to determine the appropriate action weighing patient care issues.

The administration of this facility will authorize and delegate authority to Mr. Payne to appropriate funds required to maintain our radiation safety program within the objectives of our radiation safety program and related regulatory requirements.

Mr. Payne consults on a monthly basis to our facility. During his monthly visits he spends the day at our facility conducting equipment evaluations, personnel exposure reviews, and various audits of our radiation safety practices.

As described above, the Consultant-RSO provides monthly visits to our facility. In addition, he is available by phone at any time to answer questions or respond to operational issues that may arise.

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

Radiation Safety Officer - Delegation of Authority

You, Samuel L. Payne, M.S., have been appointed Radiation Safety Officer and are responsible for ensuring the safe use of radiation. You are responsible for managing the radiation protection program; identifying radiation protection problems; initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions; verifying implementation of corrective actions; stopping unsafe activities; and ensuring compliance with regulations. You are hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet those responsibilities, including prohibiting the use of byproduct material by employees who do not meet the necessary requirements and shutting down operations where justified by radiation safety. You are required to notify management if staff do not cooperate and do not address radiation safety issues. In addition, you are free to raise issues with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission at any time.
