This is to inform the parties and petitioners that the Advisory Committee on Nuclear Waste (the Committee) of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) will receive a briefing from the staff of the Division of Waste Management and Environmental Protection (DWMEP) of the NRC's Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Protection Programs (FSME) on March 21, 2007, at 1:00 PM.

The Committee was established by the Commission in June 1988 to provide independent technical advice on agency activities, programs, and key technical issues associated with regulation, management, and safe disposal of radioactive waste. The Committee has advised the Commission in the past on the guidance in NUREG-1757, *Consolidated NMSS Decommissioning Guidance*. The briefing by DWMEP will keep the Committee informed of implementation of the decommissioning guidance by NRC licensees, and in no way is connected with or has any impact on any decisions of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel established for the Shieldalloy Metallurgical Corporation proceedings.
