Dear Mr. Minahan:

By letter dated October 11, 2006 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML062910156), Nebraska Public Power District (NPPD, the licensee) informed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) that it had inaccurately characterized the annunciator system in its response to a request for additional information (RAI) from the NRC staff. The RAI was issued during review of your application for license amendment dated June 15, 1999 (ADAMS Accession No. 9906210086), as supplemented by your RAI response dated November 14, 2000 (ADAMS Accession No. ML003769924). The staff subsequently approved NPPD's application as Amendment No. 185, dated March 13, 2001 (ADAMS Accession No. ML010740220). The inaccurate information was reflected in the safety evaluation for Amendment No. 185.

The NRC staff has reviewed the information provided by NPPD in its October 11, 2006, letter regarding the inaccuracy in the RAI response, and finds that the inaccuracy did not impact the staff's conclusion in the safety evaluation for Amendment No. 185.
