NRC STAFF TESTIMONY RELATED TO HTS-1: FACILITY DESCRIPTION

Q1: Please state your name, occupation, by whom you are employed, and your professional qualifications.

A1: (YF) My name is Yawar Faraz. I am employed as a Senior Project Manager in the Technical Support Branch, Division of Fuel Cycle Safety and Safeguards, Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards. A statement of my professional qualifications is attached.

Q2: Please describe your professional responsibilities with regard to the NRC staff's ("Staff") review of the USEC, Inc.'s ("the Applicant") license application ("Application") for the proposed American Centrifuge Plant (ACP) in Piketon, Ohio.

A2: (YF) I was the Project Manager (PM) for the Staff's review of the USEC Application from 2002 until April 2006. During the time that I was the PM, I led the effort to complete the Safety Evaluation Report (SER) for the ACP.

Q3: What is the purpose of your testimony?

A3: (YF) The purpose of my testimony is to provide the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board ("Board") with the presentation requested by the Board in its Order issued on February 16, 2007 ("Order"). I have prepared a presentation addressing each of the areas raised by the Board in HTS-1. Following the additional guidance given by the Board on February 12, 2007, the presentation does not cover any classified information. However,


the presentation will include export controlled information and business proprietary information.
