Attached are the latest revisions to the Manitowoc County & Kewaunee County "2007 Nuclear Emergency Planning Information Calendar" and "A Message to Visitors in Our Community" brochure for the Kewaunee Power Station (KPS) and Point Beach Nuclear Power Plant (PBNPP). The calendar and brochure were developed by the Kewaunee and Manitowoc County Emergency Management agencies in cooperation with the Dominion Energy Company, Inc. (for the KPS), and Nuclear Management Company (for the PBNPP).

Kewaunee County lies within the KPS's 10-mile emergency planning zone (EPZ), and Manitowoc County lies within the PBNPP's 10-mile EPZ.

We request that you review these documents for conformity to Title 44, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 350 and the requirements of NUREG-0654. Please provide written comments regarding your review to the Department of Homeland Security Chicago Field Office by April 18, 2007. Please retain the previous approved emergency information and preparedness documents until we will notify you of our final approval of the 2007 version of the KWS and PBNPP calendar and brochure.
