
SUBJECT
Control No. 315978-- Re - Amendment Request by application dated January 17, 2007, for License No. 34-32570-01 to add a second Field Station, located at Supresta US LLC Plant, State Route 2, Gallipolis Ferry, West Virginia, in addition to the existing field station located at Bayers Polymers, State Route 2, New Martinsville, West Virginia. The licensee also requested the naming of two IRRSP card holding radiographers (both with 10 years experience as radiographers) as Assistant Radiation Safety Officers (ARSO), newly designated positions for this license, due to the distance between the existing and the requested new location.

SUMMARY
In a brief telephone conversation on this date, Mr. Wolfe, in response to questions asked by the license reviewer, in order to better understand the licensee's requests, related the following additional information:

1. For the requested new Field Station (for storage and use of licensed material and for occasional dispatch to a temporary job site), located at Supresta US LLC Plant, State Route 2, Gallipolis Ferry, West Virginia, radiography would be performed throughout the plant, as needed, but not in a "Permanent Radiographic Installation" nor in a "fixed location" at this Field Station.
2. Although the licensee is headquartered in North Canton, Ohio, where the licensee has a radiography license with the State of Ohio, Mr. Wolfe currently serves as the RSO for the company's activities in West Virginia, an NRC regulated State, and is currently located at their existing Field Station at Bayers Polymers, State Route 2, New Martinsville, West Virginia. The requested new Field Station, he related, is located about three hours distance from the existing Field Station, thus serving as the primary reason for requesting the addition of the Assistant RSO position at each Field Station.
3. When questioned relating to whether either proposed ARSO has had any formal training in establishing a radiation protection program, he stated neither has at this point in time and that it was his belief that it was not required, but could probably be arranged in the near future, if required.
