SUBJECT: AMENDMENT TO RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE NUMBER 29-07009-05

NJ Department of Environmental Protection's (DEP) NRC License No. 29-07009-05 authorizes the use of licensed materials in calibration standards and environmental samples.

Please amend our license to remove authorization for source or special nuclear material. In 2004, the DEP decided to suspend the operations of its' Emergency Laboratory Facility (ELF). The ELF was designed to handle a select number of environmental samples that may result from a response to a nuclear incident. It was also used to perform quality control measurements on samples which were collected as a part of the BNE's environmental surveillance program.

We possess small amounts of source and special nuclear materials without the need of specific license. The only source material ever possessed by DEP was in the form of calibration sources and environmental samples which were acquired in accordance with 10 CFR 40.22 or small quantities or source materials. The only special nuclear material ever possessed by DEP were in the form of calibration sources which were acquired in accordance with the general license provisions of 10 CFR 70.19. We are in the process of disposing all calibration sources acquired in accordance with 40.22 and 70.19.

Change items 6A and 6B to read 'Any byproduct material'. Items 7 and 8 remain unchanged.
