The objective of the site audit is to provide an overview of the site to the NRC technical specialists who will be preparing the Environmental Impact Statement and to discuss any areas of the application where more information may be needed. The NRC is also planning to hold a public scoping meeting at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 19, 2006 at the Augusta Technical College, Waynesboro Campus Auditorium, 216 Hwy 24 South, Waynesboro, GA 30830. The objective of the public scoping meeting is to obtain public comment on the issues that should be included in the environmental review. The

agenda for the public scoping meeting includes a presentation by the NRC staff on the environmental review process and project schedules, a brief question and answer period on the scoping process, and receipt of public comments. The meeting will be transcribed and the transcription will be available on the NRC webpage at a later date. Additionally, there will be an open house from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. at the same location for the public to meet one-on-one with the NRC staff.
