Dear Sir or Madam,

This is in reference to your amendment requesting that Mr. Perna be named Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) on your license. Please be advised, Mr. Perna presently has obligations at 15 NRC licensed facilities.

1. In support of your request, please confirm that the individual fulfilling the responsibilities of the Radiation Safety Officer to be an individual who:

a. Has obtained written attestation, signed by a preceptor Radiation Safety Officer, that the individual has satisfactorily completed the requirements in paragraph (e) and in paragraphs (a)(1)(i) and (a)(1)(ii) or (a)(2)(i) and (a)(2)(ii) or (b)(1) or (c)(1) or (c)(2) of 10 CFR 35.50, and has achieved a level of radiation safety knowledge sufficient to function independently as a Radiation Safety Officer for a medical use licensee; and

b. Has training in the radiation safety, regulatory issues, and emergency procedures for the types of use for which a licensee seeks approval. This training requirement may be satisfied by completing training that is supervised by a Radiation Safety Officer, authorized medical physicist, authorized nuclear pharmacist, or authorized user, as appropriate, who is authorized for the type(s) of use for which the licensee is seeking approval.

2. In support of your request to authorize Drs. Potts and Sharma for materials permitted under 10 CFR 35.500, please provide a previous license number (if issued by NRC) or a copy of the license (if issued by an Agreement State) on which the physician was specifically named as an authorized user for the use requested, or

a. Has completed 8 hours of classroom and laboratory training in basic radionuclide handling techniques specifically applicable to the use of the device. The training must include:

- (1) Radiation physics and instrumentation;
- (2) Radiation protection;
- (3) Mathematics pertaining to the use and measurement of radioactivity; and
- (4) Radiation biology; and

b. Has completed training in the use of the device for the uses requested
In order to continue our review, we request that you submit a response as soon as possible.
