On March 7, 2007 U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) personnel visited the headquarters of UniStar Nuclear (UniStar) in Baltimore, Maryland to gather information for development of the Office of New Reactor's (NROs) licensing program plan (LPP). The LPP is an integrated resource loaded scheduling tool that is intended to facilitate the various reviews of new reactor applications. A list of participants in the visit may be found in the Enclosure.

The nature of the information discussed was of a detail that is not normally submitted to the NRC but is useful in development of NRO's infrastructure activities. UniStar personnel discussed the details of the development of the combined license application that will reference the US Evolutionary Power Reactor (EPR) with respect to planning and ties to the AREVA's US EPR design certification document.

The intent of the meeting was to gather information to inform NRO's infrastructure development and not to discuss specific potential applications. During the visit, the participants did identify topics that would be more appropriately addressed at an EPR design-centered working group (DCWG) such as the scope of the design certification application and the Combined Operating License application and how UniStar intends to deal with operational programs. UniStar and the US NRC have tentatively scheduled an EPR DCWG meeting for the morning of May 23, 2007 at the US NRC headquarters.
