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#### PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE

The base period is August 1, 2006 through August 31, 2006, with four (4) 12-month option periods. Orders up to the maximum quantities may be placed by the NRC Project Officer during the base period and option periods. Delivery orders placed by the NRC Project Officer may be verbal, but must be confirmed in writing via facsimile or mail and sent to the Contractor within ten (10) calendar days after placing the call.
