Atomic Energy of Canada, Limited (AECL) has communicated to us that additional waste material similar to that already sent to date will continue to be shipped for processing at Diversified Scientific Services, Inc. (DSSI) in Kingston, Tennessee. Import License IW012/02 is currently valid for this function.

The intent of this letter is to request a minor amendment to Export License XW008 amendment 1 to complement Import License IW012/02 and if necessary to return any non-conforming waste back to AECL. To date, Export License XW008 has never been utilized for return of non-conforming waste back to AECL.

The licensee is authorized to export 420.0 kilograms in two (two) drums containing 5.4 curies tritium and other mixed fission product radionuclides estimated quantity of non-conforming Class A Radioactive Mixed Waste that may be found in a total of 378,000 kg of such waste that DSSI is authorized by NRC license IW012 to import from Canada. DSSI to determine actual quantity of non-conforming waste which cannot be processed at its Boiler Industrial Furnace and must be returned after examining the material.

DESCRIPTION OF MATERIALS OR FACILITIES:

This license is amended to: 1) update the total quantity of imported waste material to reflect the new total already approved in import license IW012/01 (378,000 kg); and 2) extend the expiration date from March 31, 2005 to March 31, 2007.

Applicable Condition: In order to proceed with this export, DSSI is required to obtain prior consent from the US Environmental Protection Agency by providing an advance Notification of Intent to Export Hazardous Waste to a Foreign Source in accordance with 40 CFR § 262.53. DSSI is also responsible for complying with all other applicable Federal and State regulations.

The increase in the quantity of material is for administrative purposes only (to match the corresponding import license).

All other conditions remain unchanged.
