We are in receipt of a letter dated March 7, 2007 from Roy P. Zimmerman, Director of the Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response at the NRC notifying the State of Missouri of the availability of additional dosages of liquid potassium iodide (KI).

After review of previous analysis, the State of Missouri will continue its strategy of not issuing KI to the general population in the areas around the Cooper Nuclear Power Plant and the Callaway Nuclear Power Plant.

Thank you for your continued notifications regarding the NRC's KI program. After receipt of each notification the state does re-evaluate its strategic decision. Should that decision change, we would be notifying you.
