Dear Mr. Goorevich:

Enclosed is an application from Global Nuclear Fuel - Americas, dated March 20, 2007, recently received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, requesting Amendment No. 01 to export license XSNM03398 for the export of low-enriched uranium (LEU) for ultimate use as fuel in various nuclear power reactors in Europe. The purpose of the Amendment is to: 1) extend the expiration date from June 1, 2007 to December 31, 2009; 2) increase the quantity of LEU authorized for export by 2,600.0 kilograms of uranium-235 (U-235) contained in 50,000.0 kilograms uranium; and 3) change the ultimate end user from Spain to Europe. The new cumulative total quantity of LEU authorized for export would be 5,000.0 kilograms of U-235 and 100,000.0 kilograms uranium.

Assurances from EURATOM, that the material will be subject to all of the terms and conditions of an agreement for cooperation, are required. Your assistance in obtaining the necessary assurances will be appreciated.
