

MATERIALS LICENSE

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-438), and Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter I, Parts 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 39, 40, and 70, and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, acquire, possess, and transfer byproduct, source, and special nuclear material designated below; to use such material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below; to deliver or transfer such material to persons authorized to receive it in accordance with the regulations of the applicable Part(s). This license shall be deemed to contain the conditions specified in Section 183 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and is subject to all applicable rules, regulations, and orders of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission now or hereafter in effect and to any conditions specified below.

9. Authorized Use:

- A. For temporary possession at customers facilities incident to removal and packaging of industrial gauging devices.
- B. For possession of leak test analytical samples.


10. Licensed material shall be used only at customer facilities located at temporary job sites of the licensee anywhere in the United States where the Nuclear Regulatory Commission maintains jurisdiction for regulating the use of licensed material.

- 11. A. The Radiation Safety Officer for the activities authorized by the license is Joseph Zlotnicki.
- B. Licensed material shall be used by **Joseph Zlotnicki** or **Leonard Warbiany**.

12. The licensee shall not open gauges or remove sources from gauges containing licensed material.

13. The licensee is authorized to transport licensed material only in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR Part 71, "Packaging and Transportation of Radioactive Material."


14. The licensee shall develop, maintain and implement procedures for obtaining an agreement with customers that outline the responsibilities of both the customer and service provider, when performing service operations at a customer's facility.
