Dear Dr. Spivack:

This is in reference to your letter dated March 15, 2007 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 06-30788-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

You have requested Dr. Harold S. Wilkes to be placed on the license as an authorized user. As required by 10 CFR 35.290, for personnel who are certified by a medical specialty board whose certification process has been recognized by the Commission, must meet the requirements in paragraph (c)(2) of 10 CFR 35.290. Section (c)(2) states that you must obtain a written attestation, signed by a preceptor authorized user who meets the requirements in §§ 35.290 or 35.390 and 35.290(c)(1)(ii)(G), or equivalent Agreement State requirements, that the individual has satisfactorily completed the requirements in paragraph (a)(1) or (c)(1) of this section and has achieved a level of competency sufficient to function independently as an authorized user for the medical uses authorized under §§ 35.100 and 35.200.

Please submit the attestation statement. It is recommended to document the attestation statement on a NRC Form 313A (AUD) (enclosed).

Please submit evidence that the preceptor being used for the attestation statement is an authorized user who meets the requirements in §§ 35.290 or 35.390 and 35.290(c)(1)(ii)(G), or equivalent Agreement State requirements. This can be demonstrated by supplying the number of a NRC license in which the preceptor is an authorized user, a copy of the agreement state license, or a letter from the Radiation Safety Officer stating that they are an Authorized user for these types of materials.
