
SUMMARY
In a telephone conversation with Mr. Rygwelski on this date, I related our current mailing address is **2443 Warrenville Road, Suite 210, Lisle, IL 60532-4352** and that we will need the following additional information before proceeding with their request for license termination:

1. Please specify the date you transferred back to the manufacturer, Hewlett-Packard, (as stated in your letter dated January 31, 2007) both Hewlett-Packard Model G1223A ECD cells containing plated sources of Nickel-63.
2. Please provide us a copy of a letter or record from Hewlett-Packard confirming their receipt from you of both ECD cells/sources, referenced in Item 1 above.
3. Please provide us a copy of the leak test records, current as of the date of transfer, for both ECD cells/sources, referenced in Item 1 above, which confirms their non-leaking status.
4. Please confirm that no leaking sealed sources were ever possessed by the subject licensee, under License No. 21-16136-02, based on routine leak test data.

Licensee was requested to provide response, in writing, to me (as additional information to Control Number 316028), by facsimile at 630-515-1078. No follow-up hard copy is needed.
