Dear Mr. Miner:

I am responding to your amendment request dated March 16, 2007 (AET 07-0014), in which you transmitted information regarding the proposed addition of classified computer networks to the American Centrifuge Lead Cascade Facility (Lead Cascade). As you noted in your letter, this change required review of a license amendment request to revise Chapter 2 of the Security Program.

In accordance with your amendment request, and pursuant to Parts 70 and 95 to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*, the Security Program changes requested for the Lead Cascade are hereby approved. An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c).

Your letter dated March 7, 2007 (AET 07-0006), in which you transmitted three detailed security plans for establishing a classified computer network, is currently in review and remains on schedule as outlined in our acceptance letter.
