This is in response to instructions from Patricia Milligan through electronic mail on March 5, 2007. That letter provided instructions for the State of Vermont to request liquid potassium iodide (KI) for segments of the population in the ten mile emergency planning zone (EPZ) around the Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station in Vernon, Vermont. In accordance with those instructions, I am providing the following information:

The number of liquid KI bottles requested is 1,000. I understand that this is one case of 1,000 bottles each of 30 milliliter in volume.


